He also won awards like being crowned Zimbabwe's Annual National Sports Awards (ANSA) Sportsperson of the years 2009 and 2017, and Sportsman of the years 2009, 2013 and 2017. In 2018, he scooped Silver at the Annual National Sports Awards.

Besides being an athlete, Samson Muripo also holds various administrative portfolios. He has organized many local Kyokushin Karate tournaments and seminars, improving local talent and above all, he organized the first International So-Kyokushin Karate Championship on July the 22nd of 2017 at The Aquatic Complex in Chitungwiza. This was after successfully hosting continental championships in 2015 and 2016. Both these events attracted regional and international athletes, confirming the sport could give a boost to sports tourism.
